- 195.1.1 Upload the assessment management X019LL reports
- 195.1.2 Via communication lines available at connection remotes
- 195.1.3 One, eight, and nine.
- 195.1.4 Avoid reference errors.

- 195.4.3 Human classes 72-82 are recommended to supplement reports,

- 195.4.4 Especially X22C and XD1M-XD1P,
- 195.4.5 With supplemental form 1B.
- 195.4.6 Termination charges are to be processed following required stopjumps.
- 195.4.7 Human classes 12-71 should refer to section 5 subsection 13 for pertinent switch rules
- 195.4.8 Or containment regulations.
- 195.4.9 Human classes 2-11 shall be exempt from process demands until the following quarter.

- 195.5.1 Code 195 shall be regarded as applicable for all feature-directs.
- 195.5.2 When pursuing objective standards of Special Code 233,
